Dear U.S. Citizen,

Thank you for signing up for an appointment for passport services at the U.S. Consular Section in Pristina.

Extra pages are available only to legacy passport holders (not for e-passports) and only until December 2015, at which time this service will no longer be available.

If your legacy passport is still valid and in good condition, but you've run out of pages for visas and entry/exit stamps you can apply for additional pages. However, we recommend that you apply for a new 52 page passport book. Extra pages cannot be added to any e-passports or to old-style passports which are in poor condition, damaged, mutilated or if there is insufficient empty pages.

If you scheduled an appointment for extra pages and decide instead to apply for a new passport, you may continue with your appointment – you do not need to reschedule. Please review our website for instructions to apply for a new passport and ensure you bring the appropriate forms and fees, depending on which service you decide to continue with.

U.S. CITIZENS must submit:

- Completed and signed [DS-4085](#) Application for Additional Visa Pages.
- Fill out your application online, print the completed application, including a 3D barcode on the top left corner, and bring the application to the interview.
- Current U.S. non e-passport ([e-passport](#) holders must apply for a new 52 page passport book)
- Fee of \$82 (cash only). All fees are payable in U.S. dollars or EURO at the Embassy's exchange rate. A combination of U.S. dollars and EURO cannot be accepted.

Tips for smooth visit at the Consular Section

When visiting the Embassy, please remember not to bring mobile phones or any electronic devices (such as Blackberries, iPods, or PDAs), also food/drinks, medicine, cosmetic products, as they are not allowed within the Embassy. We also strongly advise that you do not bring large bags, such as backpacks, suitcases to the US Embassy as they are subject to inspection and can delay your entry inside the Consular Section.
