



## **Student Visa Tips**

- Don't wait! Sign up for a visa appointment as soon as you receive your **I-20 form** or **acceptance letter** from your university. It may take a few weeks to process your visa, so it's important to apply as early as possible for your student visa.

- Initial-entry applicants may not enter the United States more than **30 days** before the start date of their academic program noted on the I-20.
- If you are a student with an imminent school start date and would like to request an expedited visa appointment, please visit **<http://ustraveldocs.com/kw/kw-niv-expeditedappointment.asp>** for assistance.
- Copies of your I-20 form from your university may be accepted in order to pay your SEVIS fee and make a visa appointment, but your **original** I-20 form is required before we can issue the visa.

### **For your interview, don't forget to bring:**

- Completed online application form (DS-160)
- Passport and 1 copy of your passport photo page (must have a minimum validity of 6 months)
- Photo (5cm x 5cm in size, taken within the last six months, must have a white background)
- Application fee receipt from Burgan Bank
- SEVIS registration fee receipt – pay online at **<https://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/index.jsp>**
- I-20 form from your school
- Evidence of financial support (bank statement or salary letter) or sponsorship letter from the government (if applicable).

**Apply Early, Get to Class on Time!**
