- Completed the first, second, or third year of an accredited undergraduate degree program
- Demonstrated leadership through academic work, community service, or extracurricular activities
- Students who have studied abroad in other countries are not eligible for this program

Application Information

- The first step in the application process is to register. Applicants must provide proof of citizenship, university enrollment, a copy of their most recent transcripts, and an essay on why they wish to study in the U.S. (500 words maximum). **The closing date for registration is November 7, 2013.** Qualified applicants will be asked to take an English screening test, which will be administered on **November 09, 2013.**

- Applicants who pass the English Screening Test will be invited to take the TOEFL (iBT) test in January 2014 (exact date to be determined) and complete the full UGRAD application form. The deadline for submitting this application is **December 17, 2013.**
