- Lao citizens, 24 years or younger at the time of application;
- Completed the first, second, or third year of an accredited undergraduate degree program;
- Demonstrated leadership through academic work, community service, or extracurricular activities.
- Students who have studied abroad in other countries are not eligible for this program.

Application Information

- The first step in the application process is to register. Students will be requested to have proof of citizenship, university enrollment, a copy of their most recent transcripts, and an essay on why they wish to study in the U.S. (500 words maximum). **The closing date for initial registration is October 23, 2009.** Qualified applicants will be asked to take an English screening test, which will be administered on **November 6, 2009.**

- Applicants who pass the English Screening Test will be invited to take the TOEFL (iBT) test in January, 2010 (date will be notified); and at the same time the successful applicants will need to fill out the UGRAD application form. **The deadline for completion of these applications is November 25, 2009.**
