Application Process and Dates:

- 1) **November 15, 2010:** Complete registration form and submit proof of citizenship (copy of ID card, family registration, or passport); university enrollment; a copy of your most recent transcript; and an essay on your community service and extracurricular activities and why you wish to study in the U.S. (500 words maximum).
- 2) **November 20, 2010:** Qualified applicants will be invited to take an English screening test.
- 3) **December 10, 2010:** UGRAD application form due for applicants who pass the English screening test.
- 4) **January 2011** (date to be determined): Applicants with completed applications will take the TOEFL (iBT) test.
- 5) **February/March 2011:** Successful candidates will be notified of their award.
