The U.S. Embassy is seeking an individual for the position of **Welder** within the Facility Operations and Maintenance Section.

BASIC FUNCTION OF POSITION:

Serves as welder responsible for performing various types of skilled welding (to include gas plating) and other forms of metal work. Maintains fire extinguishers located in all office and residential buildings. Sets up and operates precision metal working machines to fabricate, modify and repair parts for equipment and machinery.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Completion of secondary school is required. Full completion of vocational training recognized as producing welder is required.
2. 2 - 3 years experience welding experience is required.
3. Level III English (Good working knowledge of spoken and written) is required.
4. Must have full knowledge of the welding trade. Must have knowledge of the use of equipment related to the trade. Must have full knowledge of the various types of welding.
5. Must have excellent skills as a welder. Must have the ability to lift materials and equipment off-site. Must have the ability to perform in accordance with diagrams and instructions.
