The American Embassy in Monrovia has a requirement for a contractor to provide the following:

Description:

1. New 14-Seater LHD Wheelchair Lift Bus (equipped with a wheelchair lift to help wheelchair-bound riders to get on and off the bus)

- Lift type: On-Floor (installed inside the bus)
- Lift Location: Rear (back/side)

Accommodations:

- Two (2) wheelchair-bound riders along with wheelchair restraint systems.
- Twelve (12) Regular seats (non-wheelchair riders)

- Model year: Current
- Transmission: Manual transmission
- Fuel type: Diesel
- Seat Material: Cloth / Vinyl
- Steering: Power steering
- Door: Folding door with buzzer and jam protection
- AC: Air conditioning
- Brake: ABS
- Seat belt: 3-point fitted on all seats
- Window: Rear emergency exit window

QUANTITY = 1 (one) BUS

Delivery:

120 days after receipt of purchase order.

Additional requirements/specification: *The contractor is required to submit photographs on the interior and exterior of the proposed vehicle. The contractor must demonstrate proof of original equipment manufacturer parts for vehicle within Monrovia-Liberia, and include comprehensive local warranty of not less than 50,000 miles or two years. Embassy Monrovia also requires warranty coverage against material defects and workmanship on all installed accessories. The Embassy may conduct a full assessment of local spare parts availability as well as locally available maintenance and repair expertise prior to consideration for award. Service and parts manuals are also required for this bus, as well as the full specification and/or data sheet for the item you quote. The Government reserves the right to reject proposals that are unreasonably low or high in price.*

The Embassy intends to award a purchase order to a responsible vendor that submits an acceptable quotation at the lowest price. Your quotation should include shipping/delivery charges to the stipulated delivery address. The Embassy's payment term is net-30 days after receipt of all goods or services.

Include on your quotation a realistic delivery date, and if applicable, the weight and dimension of the shipment. The delivery address for this requirement is:
