Dave Fetter is the DCM at U.S. Embassy Luxembourg. He arrived in April 2011. His previous assignment was as U.S. Consul General in Quebec City, Quebec, Canada.

Mr. Fetter joined the U.S. Department of State in 1986 and served tours in Washington, Chad, Somalia (twice), and Tunisia. After a one-year detail to the Lockheed Martin Corporation, he returned to assignments in Washington, Australia (where he worked on the Australia – U.S. Free Trade Agreement), and – during 2006-2007 – Afghanistan. In the last of these he was the political advisor to two U.S. military brigades conducting counterinsurgency operations in ten eastern provinces of that nation.
