Demonstration Notice:

- The post-bankruptcy workers have announced another protest for today (5-28-10). They will gather in front of the Skopje at 1000hrs and walk to the Main Court Building, cross over the Goce Delcev Bridge then arrive at the Government Building. Following the Government Building they will march to the main Church on Partizanska Blvd. They issued a public apology to all drivers in Skopje in advance for disrupting traffic and asked for their understanding.
- The Professional Soldiers Union announced they will stage a protest in front of Government this evening (5-28-10) at 1900hrs. They are planning to overnight in front of the Government Building if necessary. If they do not reach an agreement with the Government by tomorrow they announced they will continue with their protest in front of EU building and U.S. embassy (for the purpose of delivering official letters).

NOTE: Both protests are expected to be peaceful in nature with police controlling the area. As with any large public gathering things could change with little to no notice, please be aware of these events and plan accordingly

Spontaneous demonstrations take place in Macedonia from time to time in response to world events or local developments. We remind U.S. citizens that even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can become violent and unpredictable. You should avoid them if at all possible. Be alert and aware of your surroundings and pay attention to what the local news media has to say.
