### Demonstration Notice:

The Embassy has received reports that a demonstration is planned for tomorrow, Saturday, November 16, beginning at 12 at noon. It is planned to move from Government House along Dame Gruev, through Macedonia Square, and will end at the revolutionary struggle museum. Traffic delays are expected.

Spontaneous demonstrations take place in Macedonia from time to time in response to world events or local developments. We wish to remind U.S. citizens that even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.

We strongly recommend that U.S. citizens traveling to or residing in Macedonia enroll in the Department of State's Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) at <https://step.state.gov/step>. STEP enrollment gives you the latest security updates, and makes it easier for the U.S. embassy or nearest U.S. consulate to contact you in an emergency. If you don't have Internet access, enroll directly with the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate.
