The U.S. Embassy in Malaysia is pleased to announce that a Consular Officer will be traveling to Penang for voter outreach and to provide routine services for Americans in the area.

At 2:00pm, Vice Consul Darren Wang will explain how expats can register to vote. At 2:30pm, he will be able to provide notary services and accept U.S. passport applications to take back to the Embassy for final processing.
