

Job Opening for Chef Position in Seoul

A high-ranking diplomat posted in Seoul, Korea, is looking for a:

Full-time CHEF

Duties: Plan and execute menus for official functions (breakfasts, lunches, dinners and receptions etc.). Ensure that all food preparation and presentation is of the highest quality; oversee the entire Kitchen operations/maintain a notebook of menus. Responsible for making shopping lists and keeping accurate records of representational and non-representational expenses. Prepare meals for official house guests as needed.

Desired Qualifications: A culinary degree and/or three years of cooking experience with international and western food. Experience in food preparation for representational functions, ability to read English recipes and plan menus with minimal supervision. Basic English language skills are required.

Benefits: If the individual selected is not a current resident of Korea, the initial cost of travel to Korea from the current country of residence will be provided by the employer. After each year of service, one round trip between Seoul and the employee's homeland will be paid. One room at the residence, uniforms and shoes will also be provided.
