### **Compact Funding Payments for October 2012 over \$24 million**

In the month of October the RMI Ministry of Finance received Compact-funded payments from the United States Government totaling \$24,231,643. These payments were for FY 2013 Compact Sector Grants for the months of October and November, Compact Infrastructure Projects for the month of October, FY 2013 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Kwajalein Landowner Payment, FY 2013 Annual Trust Fund payment, and the Kwajalein Impact Fund Grant. The breakdown of these payments is as follows:

October-November RMI Education Sector Grant, \$1,775,000  
October-November RMI Health Sector Grant, \$1,125,000  
October-November Kwajalein Environmental Impact Grant, \$40,000  
October-November Ebeye Special Needs Education Grant, \$300,000  
October-November Ebeye Special Needs Health Grant, \$300,000  
October-December RMI Education Grant for CMI, \$250,000  
MOE Schools, \$245,733  
1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Kwajalein Landowner Payment, \$6,856,500  
FY 2012 RMI Annual Trust Fund Payment, \$13,306,650  
Kwajalein Impact Fund Grant, \$32,760
