
INFORMATION REGARDING PHOTO SIZES FOR PASSPORTS

Overseas passports are issued using a computer system which uploads all the information and sends the data digitally to the passport center for printing.

Please make sure when getting your photo that it is the proper size and dimensions (see square to the right). White background is a must!

HOW DO I RENEW MY CHILD'S U.S. PASSPORT?


Renewing a passport for a minor is not as easy as for an adult. Until your child is 16 years old, the Consular Officer must witness both parents signatures and the child must be present. If one parent is not available to sign they must fill an authorization form and have it notarized. An original, unabridged birth certificate listing both parents must also be presented at the time of the application.

The current price for renewing a minor's passport is \$105. U.S. Embassies and Consulates digitally send the passport information to a processing center in the United States which prints the passport and mails them back. This gives the U.S. one of the fastest turnaround times for overseas passports. Current turnaround time for passports in Maputo is 5 to 10 business days.



FREE U.S. PUBLIC TV STATIONS ONLINE

Now U.S. Citizens overseas can watch ABC, CBS, CW, FOX, NBC, and PBS from anywhere around the world. It is now easier to signup as they no longer require a social security number or other sensitive information. Just go to <http://www.ustvnow.com> to signup for free and start watching.



USTV NOW has conceived of this free TV service for three reasons:

PEPFAR SMALL GRANTS PROGRAM



As part of the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR), the United States Embassy's Public Affairs Section in Maputo administers a small grants program that supports during a 1-year period public outreach projects focused on preventing transmission of HIV. The Public Affairs Section is currently soliciting proposals from legally registered community-based, faith-based, non-governmental and civil society organizations as well as media institutions working in the response to HIV/AIDS in Mozambique. Interested parties may submit a project proposal accompanied by a one-page summary that includes the following information: (1) name of the project and organization (2) geographic location, (3) key objectives, (4) target group, (5) primary activities, (6) expected results of the project, (7) amount of funding requested and (8) name and contact information of project coordinator. Proposals may be submitted in either English or Portuguese and pages must be numbered.
