HURRICANE SANDY DISASTER ASSISTANCE




Hurricane Sandy has made landfall and caused significant flooding damage and major power outages.

Here family members can apply for assistance, track the storm by each State and follow updates from each region. Also DisasterAssistance.gov can help locate missing family members utilizing the Red Cross and National Emergency Family Registry and Locator System (NEFRS).
