



## **Basic documents required for Diversity Visa Applicants**

**Please assemble your documents in the following order:**

**1. For the Principal Applicant (DV Winner):**

- Two photographs (2" X 2")
- Passport
- Birth Certificate
- Divorce Decree (If Applicable)
- Marriage Certificate
- Police Certificate

An applicant must present a police certificate from his or her country of nationality and, if obtainable, his or her current residence if they have been residing there for more than six months and from any countries where the applicant lived more than one year.

- Academic Certificates for all degrees including Transcripts
- Photocopies of all the above documents
- Postal Address in the U.S

**2. For DV Winner's Spouse (Husband/Wife):**

- Two photographs (2" X 2")
- Passport
- Birth Certificate
- Divorce Decree (If Applicable)
- Police Certificate
- Photocopies of all the above documents

**3. For Children:**

- Two photographs (2" X 2")
- Passport
- Birth Certificate
- Police Certificate (If child is above 16 years old)
- Photocopies of all the above documents

Every visa applicant must pay a non-refundable visa application fee of USD \$330 per person (the fee is subject to change) in the Consular section at the time of interview. Applicants may pay in NRS or USD but only cash will be accepted.

**All documents that are in other languages must be translated into English and notarized.**
