



## US Commercial Export Controls & Embargoes / US Defense Trade Controls Amsterdam, the Netherlands October 21-24, 2013

The American Embassy is pleased to once again support the Export Compliance Training Institute's annual seminar on October 21 – October 24, 2013 at the [NH Amsterdam Centre](#) on U.S. Export Control Regulations and the impact that they have on your company. The seminar will include the latest information on the United States Export Control Reform (ECR) changes that will go into full effect on October 15, 2013, as well as practical advice on how European companies can adapt and avoid costly violations. Many items will be transferred from the USML (United States Munitions List) to the CCL (Commerce Control List) and companies will need to update compliance procedures in order to stay in compliance with the U.S. rules. Expert speakers will tell you exactly what you need to know to build the optimal compliance program. Please note that as a contact of the US Commercial Service in the Netherlands, you are eligible for a 10% discount on these seminars. Government officials are eligible for a 20% discount.

U.S. export control regulations such as the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) and the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) will be covered in detail on the following days:
