



## ***FLUENCY, ACCURACY AND CONFIDENCE IN ENGLISH (FACE)*** ***January 8-13, 2012***

### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The United States Embassy is pleased to announce its third “Fluency, Accuracy and Confidence in English” (FACE) camp for secondary English language teachers between the ages of 30-50 years old. The program is a continuing initiative that the U.S. Embassy offers to teachers of English for secondary education. Candidates will be selected from schools all around the country. The objective of this program is to provide an in-country total immersion English course experience where participants will be exposed to accurate English in authentic contexts and where they will communicate with one another only in English, thus enhancing their language skills for real-world interactions. In addition, participants will learn about different aspects of American culture in order to develop a better understanding of the United States and its people. This camp will also give participants confidence in their ability to teach English and communicate with other colleagues.
