

#### Application period:

1st November 2015 - 31st January 2016.

Remember to attach supplemental forms (3 letters of reference, educational degrees and transcripts) to the online application or provide hard copies

### History of the Program & Goals

The Fulbright Program was established in 1946. The goals of the Fulbright program are to promote cultural exchange, mutual understanding, academic and personal development and sharing the Fulbright experience upon returning to home country.

The Fulbright Foreign Student Program in Niger is managed by the U.S. Embassy in Niamey at the American Cultural Center. The grant covers all tuition, transportation, housing, and health insurance expenses for successful grantees.

### Eligible Disciplines

In Niger, the Fulbright Foreign Student Program offers a grant for master's degree study in the United States.

All degree disciplines are eligible except for military studies and medical studies. Though medical degrees are not eligible, it is possible to study for a degree in Public Health.

### Eligibility requirements

- ▶ Nigerian citizenship (Nigeriens holding U.S. citizenship are not eligible)
- ▶ Academic qualifications (at least a bachelor degree or equivalent)
- ▶ Language skills (good command of English language- required TOEFL score is 550)
- ▶ Commitment to come back after the training and serve your country
- ▶ Preference will be given to candidates who have not studied in the U.S.
