**Topic:** U.S. Mission Nigeria Announces The Expanded DHL Drop Box Visa Renewal Program.

**Opening Narration:** The United States Mission to Nigeria is pleased to announce the expanded DHL Drop Box Visa Renewal Program beginning this month. This program allows certain visa applicants who have previously been issued U.S. visas to renew their visas without attending an interview.

**Question:** How significant is this expansion?

**CONS:** The expanded DHL Drop Box Visa Renewal Program now covers B1/B2 visas that have expired no more than two years prior to reissuance and F, L and H visas that have expired no more than one year prior to reissuance. **CONS: Closing:** Applicants should note that participation in this program does not guarantee visa issuance. Additionally, the consular section may request applicants to attend a visa interview in certain cases, despite having submitted their application through the Drop Box program.
