Roadwork at Mariposa Land Port requires partial southbound lane closures

The U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) will be performing roadwork at the Mariposa Land Port of Entry as part of its ongoing expansion and modernization project. This roadwork will require the temporary, partial closure of southbound lanes during the upcoming months. The construction area will encompass approximately 500 feet of southbound roadway just north of the U.S./Mexico border. Road signs will be in place to alert travelers to reduced speeds and guide the traveling public. Drivers should anticipate reduced speeds through the construction area.

Southbound privately owned vehicle (POV)/Commercial Traffic - East Lane

What: Southbound roadway **east** lane (Lane 2) will be closed for roadwork.

When: Starting Monday, July 8, 2013 thru Sunday, August 18, 2013.

Southbound POV/Commercial Traffic - West Lane

What: Southbound roadway **west** lane (Lane 1) will be closed for roadwork.

When: Starting Monday, August 19, 2013 – Monday, September 30, 2013

Note: During this period (July 8, 2013 – September 30, 2013), the Mariposa Land Port of Entry southbound lanes will be unable to accommodate oversized loads. Shippers should coordinate oversize movements with your local CBP well in advance to determine the best border crossing alternatives.

Northbound Commercial FAST Lanes

What: The Northbound Commercial FAST Lanes will be temporarily relocated two lanes to the west at the international boundary to accommodate repair work. The FAST Lanes will remain open and trucks should use the middle gate in order access these booths.

When: Starting Monday, July 22, 2013 thru Monday, July 29, 2013.

The POV and pedestrian side of the port and the outbound gates will be open normal hours during our roadwork (Daily 6 a.m. - 10 p.m). GSA will advise the public if any changes to these closure dates are required.
