

Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning Technician (2016-36)

The U.S. Embassy is seeking a Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Technician to accomplish skilled maintenance and repair work throughout the Embassy buildings, grounds and residential owned/leased properties.

We are looking for an individual with the following qualifications

- Completion of secondary school is required and completion of vocational training from an accredited institute recognized as producing journeyman level technicians with a concentration in HVAC principles and application is required.
- 3 years' experience as an HVAC Technician working with large, modern, commercial or Government office building operations and maintenance is required.
- Ability to use tools of the trade and Building Automation System (BAS) in order to install, troubleshoot and repair building HVAC/mechanical systems and work with the controls technicians on associated devices is required.
- Level III (Good working knowledge) Speaking/Reading/Writing English and Norwegian is required.
- Possession of a Category 1, F-Gas certification for refrigeration is required.
- Valid driver's license class B is required.

In order to be considered for the position, applicants must address each qualification criterion above with specific and comprehensive information supporting each item.

Applications

All applicants must fulfill work and residence requirements for Norway. The Embassy does not sponsor work permits. Applicants should submit their CV and Covering Letter **in English** setting out their motivation for the role and how they meet the above criteria. The closing date for applications is October 19, 2016.

Kindly note that your application will only be considered if:

1. Your application has been sent within the time frame requested.
2. Your application documents are fully in English.
3. Your application addresses each qualification criterion outlined above.
4. Your application documents are in .pdf format.

Please be advised that the Embassy will not be able to meet the travel costs incurred when travelling to the interview, nor the costs connected with relocation if offered a position.
