The U.S. Embassy in Islamabad is seeking an individual for the position of Custodian Team Leader in the Facility Management Office.

BASIC FUNCTION OF POSITION:

The incumbent supervises cleaners/janitors work force engages in cleaning the embassy compound and residences. Receives instructions by work orders and cleaning schedule from the supervisor. Assigns crew to specific tasks and issues instructions for what is expected, checks work in progress, ensures that cleaning equipment and cleaning supplies are available for use by the janitorial work force. Performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

NOTE: *All applicants must address each selection criterion detailed below with specific and comprehensive information supporting each item.*

- 1. EDUCATION:** Completion of five years of education is required.
- 2. EXPERIENCE:** One year experience in custodial work in a supervisory position is required.
- 3. LANGUAGE:** Level I (rudimentary knowledge) Speaking/Reading/Writing of English and Level II (limited knowledge) Reading/Writing/Speaking of Urdu is required.
- 4. KNOWLEDGE:** Must have a good knowledge of janitorial techniques.
- 5. ABILITIES & SKILLS:** Must have ability to supervisor the crews working on vacuum cleaners, carpet shampoos, usage of chemical for cleaning, and other related equipment.

SELECTION PROCESS:

When equally qualified, U.S. Veterans will be given preference. Therefore, it is essential that the candidate address the required qualifications above in the application.

ADDITIONAL SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Management will consider nepotism/conflict of interest, budget and residency status in determining successful candidacy.
2. Current employees serving a probationary period are not eligible to apply.
3. Current employees with an Overall Summary Rating of Needs Improvement or Unsatisfactory on their most recent Employee Performance Report are not eligible to apply.
4. Applicants for the position must meet the required qualifications as advertised in the vacancy announcement.
5. Current employees who have voluntarily reassigned/promoted from one position to another are not eligible to apply for six months from the effective date of the reassignment/promotion.
6. Current employees who have received any job-related training are not eligible to apply in another section/agency for six months from the effective date of the training.
7. Candidates need to indicate on the Application for Employment if any family member is working in the U.S. Mission, Pakistan and, if so, in which section.
8. U. S. Mission Pakistan will not bear any travel expenses for testing, interviews, pre-employments clearances (if selected) or relocating for joining.
