### Public Diplomacy Specialist

The U.S. Embassy Koror is seeking to employ a **Public Diplomacy Specialist (Trainee Level)**, with the potential to move to full grade (LES-10).

The Public Diplomacy Specialist will report directly to the Mission Deputy. The incumbent will have primary responsibility for all Public Diplomacy programs for the U.S. Embassy. Manages a variety of outreach activities for the Ambassador, organizes guest speaker programs, and advises the Ambassador and Mission Deputy on timely media strategies to further U.S. goals in the Pacific. Develops innovative cultural and educational programs to further mission goals. Initiates the development and implementation of the embassy's strategic communication plan in the area of emerging media outreach, including social networking.

A successful candidate **must** have the following minimum qualifications: Completion of four years of college or university study in journalism, communications, marketing, business management/administration, history, or social sciences. Two years of experience in communications media as a journalist, writer, researcher, radio broadcaster, audio-visual specialist, or a combination of similar experience. Level IV (Fluent) Reading/Speaking/Writing English and Palauan language. Excellent knowledge of Palau's media, political, economic and social structure, as well as an understanding of Palau's culture. Should have excellent knowledge of public affairs, information programs, and media techniques. Extensive knowledge of the social networking system is required.
