This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; offers are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation number is *SPM07016Q0074* and is issued as a Request for Quotation. The solicitation/contract will include all applicable provisions and clauses in effect through *FAC 2005-89*. NVGs Assessment: The offeror has to create a program for SENAN evaluating their environment for NVGs. Also, they have to provide instructors to teach SENAN how they have to plan. The service required is:

- Strategic Plan for procurement
- Strategic Plan what they need for NVG (Accessories, places, trainings, etc.)
- Strategic Plan required for training structure, maintenance, how to use equipment
- Strategic Operational Plan
- Strategic Logistic Plan

This means NVG Manual Program. The offeror is responsible:

- Travel
- Lodging
- Conference Room
- Workspace
- All their personnel need to elaborate this guide for SENAN. The offeror has 14 days after visiting SENAN, Howard to deliver the final guide. For your reference: SENAN has 10 helicopters & 10 pilots.
