

**PEACE CORPS/PANAMA SEEKS A
SHORT-TERM TECHNICAL TRAINER FOR
WATER, SANITATION and HYGIENE (WASH) PROJECT**

The Technical Trainer serves as a member of the Programming and Training Unit (PTU) staff and has the responsibility of supporting the planning, development, implementation and facilitation of the Peace Corps training system for the [WASH project](#).

Duties:

- Develop environmental health training materials on water and sanitation systems and hygiene education.
- Facilitate technical and intercultural training in formal (classroom settings) and non-formal setting (including field activities) to North Americans using participatory methodologies.
- Oversee logistics and implement problem-solving strategies to overcome challenges during training events.
- Provide performance feedback and guidance to program trainees to support their learning.
- Collaborate with training, language, and program staff to ensure the training program runs efficiently and effectively according to the training continuum.
- Provide technical and emotional support to program trainees to ensure participants are safe and healthy during the training program.

Qualifications:

- Educational background in environmental fields or training fields.
- Demonstrated knowledge (and work experience desirable) in designing, constructing or managing rural aqueducts and sanitation systems with an emphasis on promoting health and hygiene practices.
- Experience in designing & facilitating training sessions, curriculum design and materials development.
- Experience working in rural and indigenous communities; training small groups, local organizations or community groups.
- Minimum of two years' experience working or studying in a cross-cultural environment.
- Good organization and time management skills; willingness to take initiative; excellent teamwork skills, strong service attitude; personal integrity; flexibility; strong interest in Panama's development.
- Knowledge of computer systems and the Internet.
- Must be fluent in Spanish and English Languages.
- Ability to spend 20% of time working in the "interior"/ rural areas under harsh conditions, including hiking long distances.
- Driver's license and ability to drive 4x4 vehicles manual transmission on rough roads.
