Duties:

- Facilitate technical and intercultural training in formal (classroom settings) and non-formal setting (including field activities) to North Americans using participatory methodologies
- Provide logistical and budget support for workshops and trainings throughout of Panama

- Travel 75% in interior visiting volunteers and community and agency counterparts, requiring an ability to drive 4x4 manual transmission on rough roads.

- Experience in training of trainers in different technical topics and proven ability to conduct training activities using the related technical terms in English and Spanish
- Experience in teaching methodology for technical trainers
- Experience in basic principles of curriculum design and in materials development
