

1. Section 1, sub-section III, paragraph B and C, Specifications are modified, accordingly DELETE and REPLACE with:

B. Specifications:

- Chain link fence fabric, hot dip galvanized steel wire, 3.76mm, 50mm mesh x 1500mm H, KK GAW 1.2 oz.
- Double swing gate posts 73mm OD , Schedule 40
- Single gate posts , corner posts and line posts , 60.3mm OD , Schedule 40
- *Gate frame should be 1.50" NPS (48.3 mm OD) (NPS 1-1/2") (typical 4 sides) schedule 40 steel pipe, galvanized with a minimum zinc coating weight of 1.2 oz/ft². Typically in the Industry, the minimum zinc coating weight of schedule 40 pipe is 1.8 oz/ft² (550 gr/m²). The mesh or fabric shall be secure to gate frame with tension bars 3/16" X 5/8" minimum (Typical 4 sides). Tension and brace bands galvanized shall be minimum material thickness of 12 gauges and a minimum width of 3/4" (19 mm), and galvanized with a minimum of 1.2 oz/ft² of zinc which are commonly used.*
- Top & bottom rail , 42mm OD , Schedule 40
- Fence fittings Caps, clamps, bars, bands, rail ends, nuts and bolts, galvanized 1.2 oz.
- Gate hardware, Hinges, Fulcrum latches, Drop rod, gate keepers, galvanized 1.2 oz.
- Aluminum ties, 9ga. / 3.76mm, spacing: 450mm o.c.
- Concrete footer 300mm diameter x 600mm depth for gate & line posts
- Concrete footer 300mm diameter x 500mm depth for line posts.
- Drycrete. Concrete in bags. 3000 psi. / 28 days.
- *The distance between posts will be 3 meters. The distance between the finish grade and the bottom horizontal rail will be 64 mm (2.5") as indicated on the Galvanized Chain Link Fence Single and Double Swing Gate Detail 5 and 6 respectively. Leave approximately 50 mm (2") between finish grade and bottom of fabric.*

C. All materials meeting the following standards:

Wire fabric ASTM A-392 Class 1, Steel pipe ASTM F-1043 and ASTM F1234, Fittings ASTM F-626, Bolts ASTM A153, ASTM C31.

Schedule 40 pipe, ASTM A 53 and protective coating per ASTM F 1043 will be acceptable.

Vendor shall send a Material Submittal Letter informing about the materials that he intends to use in the project; could be included material description and specifications, datasheet, catalog or samples.

2. Section 1, sub-section corrected IV, paragraph B, Delivery Location and Time is modified, accordingly DELETE and REPLACE with

B. Delivery time:

- (a) Commence within five (5) working days after the date the Contractor receives the Notice to Proceed (NTP).
- (b) Complete the entire work ready for use not later than thirty (30) calendar days after receiving the NTP or *sixty (60) calendar days to procure material from a foreign country.*

The time stated for completion shall include final cleanup of the premises and completion.
