USAID, NZAP Analyze PNG Agribusiness

Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea - The United State Agency for International Development (USAID), in collaboration with the New Zealand Aid Programme (NZAP), will conduct an assessment of the agribusiness sector environment in Papua New Guinea January 29 – February 12.

The USAID Agribusiness Commercial Legal and Institutional Reform (AgCLIR) assessment team will meet with representatives from key stakeholders in the public sector, private sector and civil society. The objective is to identify policy, legal and institutional constraints that affect the start-up and growth of agribusinesses in Papua New Guinea. The assessment will provide clear, actionable recommendations for reforms to improve the enabling environment for agribusinesses.

The AgCLIR assessment for Papua New Guinea is funded through generous contributions from Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC), New Zealand Aid Programme and USAID Bureau for Food Security.
