

E-teacher Program

What's the E-Teacher Program?

This program offers foreign English language educators the opportunity to complete a university-level online professional development course. University of Oregon administers the current program. Scholarships cover tuition and course materials. Participants use online tools to participate in discussion boards and complete assignments. Participants who successfully finish a course receive a certificate of completion from the course provider. The courses last 10 weeks, and they begin in different times of the year (US fall of 2014 [Oct 6, 2014], winter 2015 [Jan 5, 2015], spring 2015 [Apr 6, 2015] and summer of 2015 [Jun 22, 2015]).

Who is eligible?

- Paraguayan citizens
- Not hold dual citizenship in the United States;
- Possess required English language abilities:
- High intermediate to advanced English language skills, particularly in reading and writing; be able to complete academic work at a U.S. university level
- General understanding of English technical terms relating to digital technology and the Internet

Selection Criteria

- E-Teacher candidates should be current ELT professionals (e.g., teachers, teacher trainers, program administrators)
- Should be highly motivated individuals who are dedicated to their own professional development and to sharing the knowledge they gain with colleagues in their local area.
- Candidates should be committed to fulfilling all program requirements, which include dedicating at least 8-10 hours to course work per week.
- Candidates should be committed to organize a workshop after the completion of the program to share the new knowledge with their peers.
