QUESTION 1

What if a student needs to leave the school before the normal schedule? Who is responsible for taking the student from school to Home? Parents? or Bus Company?

QUESTION 2

Is the IPS insurance required for Bus Drivers and Monitors?

YES, it is mandatory.

QUESTION 3

Do the Buses need to get Asuncion's permits to provide the service? Like vehicular and Municipal Permits

YES, they are mandatory

QUESTION 4

Do the Buses need any special painting that allows them to work as School Bus Service provider?

YES, it should be according to the Transit Bylaw of Asuncion

QUESTION 5

SECTION 1 - 2.0 TYPE OF CONTRACT - 2.1 Standard Services

Please provide the following the following clarification:

The estimated quote shall be on monthly or per worked day basis? since both type of factors are incompatible with each other. If the estimated calculation is made on monthly basis, payment must be for the worked month, if the Embassy would like to pay per worked day then we'll quote the service per worked day.

Contractor is required to provide monthly prices per student. Service must be provided from Mondays thru Fridays except holidays and other days specifically designated by the School and listed in the Solicitation.
