



In Fiscal Year 2012, the Department of State estimates it will process 10.5 million nonimmigrant visas and one million immigrant visas. Based on an update to the Bureau of Consular Affairs' cost-of-service model conducted in December 2011, we are adjusting the fees for processing these visas to better reflect the costs of providing these services. On April 13, 2012, we will adjust nonimmigrant and immigrant visa processing fees as follows:

-- B1/B2, B1,B2, C1, C1/D, F1, J1	\$140 to \$160
-- H, L, O, P, Q, and R NIVs	\$150 to \$190
-- E NIVs	\$390 to \$270
-- K NIVs	\$350 to \$240
Processing fee for:	
-- Immediate Relative/Family-based IVs	\$330 to \$230
-- Employment-based IVs	\$720 to \$405
-- Other IVs (I-360 and special IVs)	\$305 to \$220
Fee for:	
-- DV program applicants	\$440 to \$330
-- Determining returning resident status	\$380 to \$275
-- Transportation letter for LPR	\$165 to no fee
-- IV security surcharge	retired
