U.S. Embassy Delivers \$40,000 of Computers and Equipment to Peru's Office of the Anti-Drug Public Solicitor

LIMA, MAY 3, 2012 – The U.S. Embassy in Lima today delivered more than \$40,000 worth of computers and office equipment to Peru's Office of the Anti-Drug Public Solicitor. U.S. Embassy Narcotics Affairs Section head Jeffrey Hovenier delivered the five laptop computers, five laser printers, two copy machines, and ten shelving units to Public Solicitor Sonia Media at the Anti-Drug Public Solicitor headquarters in Lince. The equipment will help support the important work of the public solicitors who represent the state in cases related to drug trafficking and money laundering tied to drug trafficking. This most recent delivery is part of broader U.S. support to Peru's efforts to combat drug trafficking and related money laundering. The U.S. Embassy has also funded this year a \$620,000 training package through the Organization for American States Inter-American Drug Abuse Control Commission (OAS/CICAD) to fight money laundering and terrorist finance in Peru.
