

**Terms:**

1. The term "Participant" refers to the "Jestem z Ukrainą" campaign.
2. The "Participant" is the user who submitted a photograph of him holding a sign: "Jestem z Ukrainą."
3. A "Submission" is any photo submitted to the Campaign not later than 23:59:59 CET April 6, 2014.
4. All Submissions must contain a photograph.

**Eligibility:**

1. Participant must be at least 16-years old on the date of the commencement of the Campaign.
2. Participant must be a citizen of Poland.
3. The Campaign commences at 13:00:00 CET March 27, 2014 and ends at 23:59:59 CET April 6, 2014.

**General Requirements:**

1. Participant must submit by e-mail a short photo with the following statement: "Jestem z Ukrainą".
3. Aside from the photo, an e-mail must include the Participant's last name (and maiden name if applicable), and first name.
4. Participant must send the submission to EmbassyWarsawFacebook@state.gov by 23:59:59 CET April 6, 2014.
