

Terms

1. The term "Contest" refers to the "Basketball camps in the U.S." Contest.
2. The "Contestant" is the user who submitted a video.
3. A "Video Submission" is any eligible video submitted to the Contest not later than 23:59:59 CET October 26, 2014.
4. All Submissions must be in English, and contain a link to one video.
5. The "Contestant" must provide a signed scanned agreement of a parent or a legal guardian to participate in the Contest and in the program in the U.S.
6. The "Contestant" must have a passport valid for the next 12 months from the date when the Contest commences.
7. The Contest consists of two stages. 16 finalists will be chosen by the jury for stage no 2. Out of these 16 finalists the jury will select 8 winners.
8. The organizer reserves the right to clarify the length of stay within up to two weeks before the scheduled departure.
9. There are 2 programs (planned for January and April 2015), each will be attended by 4 winners. The jury will decide which program is attended by which winner. The first program will be attended by 2 girls and 2 boys, the second program will be attended by 4 girls.
10. The programs will be also attended by contestants from the following countries: Georgia, Lithuania and Ukraine.
11. Each Polish group will be chaperoned throughout the travel and program by one basketball coach chosen by the Embassy.

Eligibility

1. Contestant must be between 13-17 years old on the date of the commencement of the Contest.
2. Contestant must be a citizen of Poland.
3. Previous video-making experience is neither required nor prohibited.
4. The Contest commences at 00:14:00 CET October 9, 2014 and ends at 23:59:59 CET October 26, 2014.
5. To submit a video entry, Contestant must have a Youtube.com account. There is no fee or charge to become a registered user.
6. The following individuals are not eligible to enter the Contest: employees, directors and officers of the Contest Sponsors, the U.S. government, as well as contractors of the U.S. government; distribution, web design, advertising, fulfillment, judging and Contest agencies involved in the administration, development, fulfillment and execution of this Contest (collectively, "Contest Parties"), and the immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and spouse or "step" of each) and those living in the same households of each such individual.
8. No entry fee is necessary to participate or win in the Contest. The Contest is void where prohibited by law, regulation, statute or other appropriate authority.

General Requirements

1. Video Submissions must reflect Contestant's basketball skills and English language knowledge.
2. Video submissions have to be maximum 1 minute long.
3. Contestants submitting Video should upload it on Youtube.com and e-mail the direct link to embassywarsawfacebook@state.gov.
4. Contestants must submit their full name, contact telephone number, city of residence and date of birth with their submission.
5. Once a Video Submission is uploaded it is considered final and may not be modified or edited.
6. By submitting any of the formats included in the Competition, the Contestant agrees that U.S. Embassy Warsaw can publish it on its Facebook Fan page: <http://facebook.com/USEMBASSYWARSAW> and on the official website <http://poland.usembassy.gov/>. U.S. Embassy Warsaw will also have a right to print and exhibit Submissions as well as distribute winning Submissions to media. Content Requirements: Video Submissions may contain content created by the Contestant
7. Any issues not described here are regulated by the information provided in the web story posted on <http://poland.usembassy.gov/>.

Content Requirements:

1. Video Submissions may contain content created by the Contestant and content in the public

domain. Video Submissions must not contain any video footage or elements of soundtrack/copyright music.

2. By uploading a Video Submission, the Contestant affirms that he or she has obtained the necessary rights, licenses, consents and permissions to use all material in the video, including but not limited to rights to use original content not produced by the Contestant alone and written consent from all individuals whose image or likeness appears in the video and that he or she is prepared to provide documentation to that effect upon request (or from parent/legal guardian if any such person(s) is considered a minor in their country of residence). Failure to obtain such rights and consents may result in the disqualification.

3. Video Submissions must not contain profanity, explicit sexual material, graphic violence, and appeals to violence or commercial promotion. Video Submissions must adhere to the norms of civil discourse and should not contain material that might be considered abusive, inflammatory or disrespectful to other groups or individuals.

Registration:

1. The person named as the registered owner of the email account associated with the Video Submission will be considered the Contestant and will be the only person eligible to compete for the prizes. In order to be eligible to win a prize, you must provide accurate and complete information.

Liabilities and Rights:

1. U.S. Embassy Warsaw does not permit copyright infringing activities or infringement of any other intellectual property rights and reserves the right to remove any Submission in violation of another party's copyright or other intellectual property rights.

2. The Contestant assumes sole responsibility for the material contained in the Submission.

3. Contestants retain ownership of their Video Submissions. However, by submitting a Message to the Contest, Contestants grant Contest a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, sub-licensable and transferable license to use, reproduce, distribute, prepare derivative works of, display, and perform Submissions in any media formats and through any media channels in perpetuity in connection with the Contest.

Judging

All Videos will be judged by Diplomats at U.S. Embassy Warsaw and a representative from the Marcin Gortat Foundation MG13, which will choose the winners. U.S. Embassy Warsaw has sole discretion over the criteria for which the winning messages will be chosen.

Prizes

Winners of the Contest will come to the U.S. for a 10 day to 2-week program involving training, nutrition, fitness, life skills, conflict resolution, disability sports, and exposure to the unique American perspective on sports.

Additional Requirement

Winners of the Contest are required to share the skills and experiences acquired in the U.S. when they return home.

Privacy

Winners of the Contest may be publicly identified by name, beyond the identification of the winners. No personally identifiable information will be sold or distributed to any third party for any other purpose.

General Terms and Conditions

If for any reason the Contest is not capable of running as planned, including without limitation, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest, U.S. Embassy Warsaw reserves the right, at their sole and absolute discretion to cancel, modify or terminate the Contest. Further U.S. Embassy Warsaw reserves the right, at any time and in their sole and absolute discretion, to disqualify and/or deem ineligible any individual they suspect (a) to have failed to agree to the Official Rules or to be violating the Official Rules; (c) to be violating the Facebook or Youtube Terms of Service, or (d) to be acting in a bad faith, unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other
