U.S. State Department Releases 2012 Human Rights Reports

Today Secretary of State John Kerry released the Human Rights Report 2012.

The annual Country Reports on Human Rights Practices – the Human Rights Reports – cover internationally recognized individual, civil, political, and worker rights, as set forth in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and other international agreements. Because human rights are a universal value and no country has a perfect record, these reports cover nearly 199 countries and territories around the world.

The reports use government and civil society reporting to document and verify information in the reports and present an objective accounting of human rights developments in every country.
