




IMPORTANT TRENDS AND HIGHLIGHTS

- Portugal is an important stop for recruiting international students. Portugal attracts thousands of students from all continents for undergraduate study.
- English is Portugal's second most spoken language and Portuguese students' average TOEFL score is 95.
- The U.S. is the 4th study abroad destination for Portuguese students, following France, the UK and Spain. (Source: UNESCO 2012)
- The proportion of the Portuguese population that is between the ages of 15-24 has declined by 20% over the past ten years, which may be a factor impacting student mobility. (Source: Eurostat, 2013)
