Questions and Answers

Q1: Please provide pictures showing condition of the floor for the First Loading Dock area (210 square meters).

A1: See pictures on page 3 of this amendment.

Q2: Is there a possibility of rain getting in the First Loading Dock (210 square meters) work area from the outside?

A2: No, but the Contractor is required to comply with all necessary safety measures stated in Section B.6 *Safety*.

Q3: Is the Contractor required to perform a thorough work site cleaning after the floor repairs are complete?

A3: Yes, as stated in Section B.5 *Cleanup of Work Site*. Per Scope of Work, this project requires floor surface grinding and leveling, so a significant dust accumulation is expected, all of which needs to be cleaned by the Contractor.

Q4: Specify if the Contractor is required to remove the existing baseboard at the Second Loading Dock area (68 square meters) and to install new baseboard after the floor repairs in that area have been finished? Is the new baseboard a Contractor or government furnished material?

A4: Yes, the removal of the old baseboard is required prior to beginning any floor repairs or floor grinding at the Second Loading Dock area (68 square meters). Also, the Contractor will be required to install the new baseboard to be provided by the Government.

Q5: What is the planned start date for this project?

A5: The anticipated start date for this project is the end of May 2016. However, the Embassy reserves the right to pick the alternate project start date based on the Embassy needs. The actual project start date will be coordinated with the Contracting Officer's Representative.

Q6: What does the foundation under the vinyl tiles in the Second Loading Dock area (68 square meters) look like? Is it concrete like the rest of the Second Loading Dock area floor (not covered by vinyl tiles)?

A6: To the best of the government's knowledge, the foundation under the vinyl tiles is the same as the rest of the Second Loading Dock area floor not covered by vinyl tiles, namely, the reinforced concrete slab. However, the Contractor is responsible for stripping the vinyl tiles and repairing/smoothing out the entire Second Loading Dock area (68 square meters) regardless of the foundation underneath.

Q7: What is the anticipated traffic load for the lower level of the First Loading Dock area (210 square meters)?

A7: Heavy loader traffic expected, but no studded tires.

Q8: How deep is the floor reinforcement from the surface of the First Loading Dock area (210 square meters)?

A8: The floor reinforcement is buried in the concrete slab under a protective layer. It is not anticipated that the Contractor will reach the floor reinforcement while repairing the loading dock area floors. However, as stated in the Scope of Work, the Contractor might be required to remove and dispose of the floor leveling guides if any are found in the floor.

➔ **New Section G.5.2 Construction Personnel:**

“The Contractor must submit to the Contracting Officer a list of workers and supervisors assigned to this project **along with the quote**. The Government will conduct all necessary security checks. It is anticipated that security checks may take 60 days to perform. For each individual the list shall include:

- Full Name
- Place and Date of Birth
- Current Address
- Passport Copy

Failure to provide any of the above information may be considered grounds for rejection and/or resubmittal of the application. Once the Government has completed the security screening and approved the applicants a badge will be provided to the individual for access to the site. This badge may be revoked at any time due to the falsification of data, or misconduct on site.”
