

Scope of Work
for
Tent Pavilion Installation

A. General:

A.1 The Contractor(s) shall visit the site at a date and time designated by the Contracting Officer to view and inspect the work area (NOB Winter garden court yard) in order to understand the existing conditions for the installation of a 9 meter by 9 meter tent with wooden flooring base.

A.2 The Contractor shall provide all labor, tools, materials, equipment, supervision and services, unless otherwise specified, to complete the work required herein. All the work and procedures shall be performed in conformity to the specifications and work requirements herein. All local labor standards for occupational safety and health apply to this contract.

B. Scope of Work

B.1. The Contractor will design, fabricate, deliver, and install a 9 m x 9 m size wood framed pavilion with railing, with roll up sides and doors panels. The contractor shall provide a written copy of the design parameters for wind and snow loads.

B.2. Pavilion shall be installed on a wooden base constructed from waterproof treated wood. Approximate height of the wooden base is 150 mm and approximately 9 m x 9 m in area.

B.3. Roof shall be made from tent tarpaulin of white or beige color. Contractor shall provide samples of the materials for the Embassy to select the color.

B.4. Pavilion shall have treated wood framed

construction with wood side banisters and tarpaulin roll walls and door panels. The walls shall have at minimum the upper half of the wall panels in clear material to allow for passage of light and vision through the panels. The lower half of the wall panels will match the color of the roof fabric. There will be separate roll up panels for the door openings with the upper half clear on each end of the tent. All wall and door panels must have system that will allow them to be tightly secured at the bottom and along the sides of the panels so the whole of the tent can be secured from the weather and to prevent the wall and door panels from flapping in the wind.

B.5. The pavilion shall be similar or equal to pavilion "Holland" type as shown in the attached picture.

C. Utilities:

Electricity, 220V 50 Hz single phase and water are available at the tent site. Electricity and water will be provided at no cost to the Contractor during the work period. Both shall be utilized solely for the contracted work and not for any other purpose.
