

DIRECTORATE GENERAL OF IMMIGRATION AND EMIGRATION TO START REGISTRATION OF ALL FOREIGNERS RESIDING IN RWANDA IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED WITH AN ELECTRONIC RESIDENT ID CARD.

The Directorate General of Immigration and Emigration (DGI&E) wishes to inform all Foreign Residents that in order for it to issue Electronic Foreign ID cards, there will be registration of all foreign residents at the District Immigration offices and Immigration headquarters.

This registration shall begin on 15th October to 01st November, 2012 as per the program below.

This registration is in line with issuance of Electronic Resident ID cards to Non-nationals residing in Rwanda, replacing paper based “Green card”. The holder shall have the right to move freely with in the Country without carrying their National passports.

This Resident card is designed like National’s ID card.

This ID card shall be machine readable and was designed according to the wishes and proposals from Non-Nationals (Customers) living in Rwanda.

This Electronic ID card shall give the holder the right to access some of the service offered National such as the right to obtain a driving license.

The Directorate General of Immigration and Emigration encourages all Non-Nationals living in Rwanda to participate in this registration campaign and reminds the concerned to come along with their passports, Laissez passer and or any other identification document in possession.
