The U.S. Embassy in Kigali Rwanda is pleased to announce the 2016-17 Young Emerging Scholars (Y.E.S.) Program. The program is a group advising program designed to assist with the undergraduate application process for students who wish to study at colleges and universities in the United States.

Students who have completed their secondary education are eligible to apply. Successful applicants will have strong academic achievement, a demonstrated record of leadership, a commitment to community service, and the initiative to study independently in their free time.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Y.E.S. program, applicants must have:

- Completed Secondary in 2015 with a strong class ranking
- Completed the National Exam with strong marks
- Demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service
- Fluency or functional English experience

Application/Selection Process

Interested applicants must submit:

- Y.E.S. application form
- A-Level Academic transcripts (S4, S5 & S6)
- National Exam scores

All interested candidates must submit the documents no later than **June 15, 2016**.
