Embassy of the United States in Bosnia and Herzegovina will hold a sealed bid sale to sell used household furniture and appliances, office furniture, computer equipment, carpets, A/C units and exercise equipment. The sale will be held on Friday, December 21st, 2012, at the U.S. Embassy Warehouse located in Rajlovac street 10a under following conditions:

- In accordance with the United States Government security regulations, all visitors are required to bring a picture I.D. card and register at the entrance of the warehouse. Visitors without a valid I.D. document will not be granted access to the warehouse.
- The items are sold on “as is” basis, with no guarantee or representation as to operating condition. All interested buyers may view offered items on the auction day from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m. Bids with properly filled form are due in sealed envelopes in the drop box located at the warehouse entrance from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m. Incomplete bids and any bids after 12:00 will not be accepted.
- Offered merchandises are being sold to individuals and for personal use only. Embassy employees (and their immediate family members) who are responsible for the selection of items to be auctioned are not eligible to place bids. Right to participate in the auction will have all prospective bidders that have previously deposited 100 KM with USG cashier on the day of the auction, from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m. at the U.S. Embassy Warehouse (Rajlovac 10a). Detailed bidding instructions and bid forms will be available at the warehouse entrance.
- The unsuccessful bidders will be able to collect previously deposited amount in full at the U.S. Embassy warehouse on Wednesday, December 26, 2012, only from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m. The unsuccessful bidders will lose the right to collect their deposits after the mentioned time frame. The successful buyers’ deposits will be deducted from the final cost of the lots won. Deposits will not be returned to those successful buyers who give up the right to purchase.
- The sealed bids will be opened on the sale day (12/21/12) in the presence of the customs and tax officers, and U.S. Embassy representatives at the Embassy building located at Roberta C. Frasurea 1. Embassy will notify winning bidders about successful purchase via phone call. The sale results and the list of the successful buyers will also be announced on Wednesday, December 26, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. at U.S. Embassy Warehouse.
- The successful buyers must settle their accounts with the cashier and customs & taxes officials exclusively between 9:00 and 12:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 26, 2012 at the U.S. Embassy Warehouse located in Rajlovac 10a. The Embassy of the United States will pay the customs expeditor’s fees, while the buyers are obligated to pay administrative taxes. All payments must be made in cash and in local currency only (konvertibilna marka). No checks/cards or other means of payment except cash will be accepted.
- All merchandises have to be removed from the U.S. Embassy Warehouse from 12:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 26, and on Thursdays and Friday, December 27 and 28, 2012 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The purchases left after this date will be disposed of and no refunds will be given. All buyers must pick up their purchases between, as the Embassy of the United States does not make deliveries.
- The U.S. Government holds its right to reject any or all bids.
