- 1. PUBLIC SALE OF USED VEHICLES and**
- 2. PUBLIC SALE OF CARGO CONTAINERS**

The Embassy of the United States will hold a sealed bid sale to sell 5 used vehicles and 8 cargo containers. The sale will be held on Tuesday, February 12, 2013. Prospective bidders are welcome to view vehicles from 9:00 to 12:00 hrs at Embassy parking lot located at Roberta Frasurea Street 1, while containers can be viewed inside the embassy compound (access from the Service CAC). Sale will be held under following conditions:

- In accordance with the United States Government security regulations, all visitors are required to bring a picture I.D. card and register at the entrance. Visitors without a valid I.D. document will not be granted access to the parking or embassy compound.
- The items are sold on "as is" basis, with no guarantee or representation as to operating condition. All interested buyers may view offered items on the auction day from 9:00 to 12:00 a.m.
- Detailed bidding instructions and bid forms for the vehicle auction will be available at the parking entrance, and for the containers auction forms will be available at the service entrance. Bids with properly filled form are due in sealed envelopes in the drop box located at the parking entrance and service entrance to the embassy compound from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Incomplete bids and any bids after 1:00 p.m. will not be accepted. Considering two different locations of the auction, each location/auction will have its own drop box.
- Embassy employees (and their immediate family members) who are responsible for the selection of items to be auctioned are not eligible to place bids. The U.S. Government holds its right to reject any or all bids.

- Winning bidders will be notified about successful purchase on Wednesday, February 13, 2013.
- All payments will be due on Thursday, February 14, from 14:00 to 15:00 at the U.S. Embassy Cashier (Roberta C. Frasurea #1) and must be made in cash (local currency only). No checks/cards or other ways of payment will be accepted. Prospective bidders are obliged to settle all customs and VAT fees.
- Unsuccessful bidders will be able to collect previously deposited amount in full as of Friday, February 15, 2013 through the aforementioned bank account at Raiffeisen Bank. Deposits of the successful bidders will be kept until final payment is made.

- All vehicles must be removed no later than 16:30 hrs. on Friday, February 15, 2013. It is mandatory to present your invoice(s) while taking over the vehicle(s). All vehicles left after this date will be disposed of and no refund given. All buyers must take over their vehicles. The Embassy will not make deliveries.

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## 2 . PUBLIC SALE OF CARGO CONTAINERS

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- Following is the list of containers for sale:
  - 4 cargo 40 foot container
  - 4 cargo 20 foot containerSome containers contain merchandise that is not being sold separately, but as a belonging part of the container
- The sealed bids will be opened on the sale day (2/12/13) in the presence of the customs and tax officers, and U.S. Embassy representatives at the Embassy building located at Roberta C. Frasurea 1. Embassy will notify winning bidders about successful purchase via phone call on the same day (2/12/13). The sale results and the list of the successful buyers will also be announced on Wednesday, February 13, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. on the board in front of the service entrance to the U.S. Embassy Compound.
- The successful buyers must settle their accounts with the cashier and customs & taxes officials exclusively between 10:00 and 12:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 13, 2013 at the U.S. Embassy Compound Service Entrance. The Embassy of the United States will pay the customs expeditor's fees, while the buyers are obligated to pay customs fees, VAT and administrative taxes. All payments must be made in cash and in local currency only (konvertibilna marka). No checks/cards or other means of payment except cash will be accepted.
- Containers have to be removed from the U.S. Embassy Compound until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 20, and in coordination with the embassy representatives. It is solely buyer's responsibility to pay and organize transportation and crane for transferring of the containers. All buyers must pick up purchased containers, as the Embassy of the United States does not make deliveries.
