



NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
CONTROL AND SUPERVISION OF WORK TO BE DONE ON
ADDUCTORS AND EMISSARIES OF THE DELTA

Ref. RFP / QCBS / No. MCA-IWRM04

1. The Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC") and the Government of Senegal have signed a Compact to reduce poverty through economic growth in Senegal (the Compact) in an amount of Five Hundred and Forty Million USD (US \$ 540 million) ("MCC Funding").
2. The Government, acting through MCA-Senegal, intends to allocate part of MCC funding to eligible payments authorized under the contract for which this RFP is prepared to fund consultant services to assist the Government **in Control and Supervision of the construction work to be done on Delta's Adductors and Emissaries**. Any payment made under the Contract will be subject in all respects, of the terms and conditions of the Compact and related documents, including restrictions on use and conditions for disbursement of MCC Funding. No party other than the Government and MCA Senegal can either claim any rights from the Compact or pretend to benefit from MCC Funding.
3. The Government is represented, as part of this Request for Proposals by MCA-Senegal. MCA-Senegal will execute the consulting services agreement resulting from the RFP. Any action contrary to this Request for Proposals, all references to actions taken or rights received by MCA-Senegal in this Request for Proposals, including the model contract would be taken into account by the Government.
4. This Request for Proposal is consistent with the General Procurement Notice published on the website of MCA-Senegal on January 13, 2012, on sites of DgMarket and UNDB respectively on the 13 and the 20 of January 2012, as well as in the local press From January 30 to February 04, 2012.
5. MCA-Senegal, on behalf of Government invites for submission of proposals related to consultancy services for the Control and Supervision of construction work to be done on **Delta's Adductor and Emissaries**. Further details regarding this Request for Proposals, are provided in the Terms of Reference.

Request for Proposal ("RFP") for the Control and Supervision of construction work on Delta's Adductors and Emissaries is open to all eligible entities or persons ("Consultants") who wish to bid. Methods of association allowed between the Consultants are the joint venture contract and

subcontracting for the provision of consultancy services in order to share complementary areas of expertise of Consultants partnering and optimize their ability to perform their duties and fulfill their missions successfully under the terms of reference.

6. Consultancy services for construction work supervision are required for varying periods according to the different work packages:

- Lot 1: Structures of the High Delta - duration: 22 (Twenty two) months
- Lot 2: Earthworks Adductors - duration: 30 (Thirty) months
- Lot 3: Emissary - duration: 30 (Thirty) months
- Lot 4: Emissary - Great books - duration: 26 (Twenty six) months

For each lot, the duration of consultancy services includes, in addition to construction supervision period, 2 additional months (1 month before the start of work and one month for visits during the warranty period).

7. A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on Quality and Cost (QCBS). The evaluation procedure is outlined in the sections of the RFP in accordance with "MCC Program Procurement Guidelines" available on the MCC website: www.mcc.gov .

8. The Dossier of the RFP includes the following sections:

Section 1: Instructions to Consultants

This section provides information to potential consultants to assist them in preparing their proposal. It also provides information on the bid, the bid opening, on the evaluation of proposals and the award procedure.

Section 2: Special Data of the RFP

This section includes provisions specific to this market, which supplement the information in Section 1 - Instructions to Consultants.

Section 3: Qualification and Evaluation Criteria

This section specifies the qualifications required for the Consultant and the criteria for evaluation of the Proposal.

Section 4A: Technical Proposal Forms

This section provides the Technical Proposal Forms to be completed by a potential Consultant and to recover, in a separate envelope with all documents required for the Consultant's Proposal.

Section 4B: Financial Proposal Forms

This section contains the Financial Proposal Forms to be completed by the potential consultants and put in a separate envelope with all documents required for the consultant's Proposal.

Section 6: Terms of Reference

This section includes the detailed Terms of Reference of this market, which exposes the nature of tasks and obligations of the Consultant and the services to provide.
