- \$540 million five year Compact signed b/w USG's MCC and Senegal in September 2009
- Entry into Force: September 2010; Implementation Period: September 2010-2015
- Compact Program: 1) expand Senegal's irrigation systems to improve agricultural productivity and 2) rehabilitate national roads to increase market and service access
  - **Roads Rehabilitation Project (USD\$324m):**
    - RN2- 120 km from Richard-Toll to Ndioum (including Ndioum Bridge)
    - RN6- 256 km from Ziguinchor to Kounkane (including Kolda Bridge)
    - For safety reasons, some market relocation/improvements envisioned
  - **Irrigation and Water Resource Management Project (USD \$170m):**
    - *Delta* : improve irrigation infrastructure unlocking 39,000 ha of irrigated land
    - *Podor*: detailed design for widespread irrigation, also works at N'Gallenka (440 ha)
    - *Land Tenure*: studies and improves land tenure in project zones
    - *Social Safeguards*: project may fund daycares, livestock centers, warehouses
  - **Program Administration and M&E (USD \$46m)**

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
## Implementation progress to date (February 2012):

- Implementation framework has been set up and final designs (technical and resettlement) are nearing completion:
  - MCA-Senegal, Compact GoS accountable entity, established, staffed and operational
  - Procurement and financial management operations ongoing by GFA/Charles Kendall
  - Banking Arrangements made with CBAO Groupe Attijariwafa
  - Delta Irrigation: EGIS BCEOM/IDEV-IC finalizing detailed technical design
  - Podor Irrigation: SCET Tunisie finalizing detailed technical design
  - Irrigation (Delta and Podor): AECOM/TECSULT Inc finalizing resettlement design
  - RN2/Ndioum Bridge: CIRA Ingenieurs Conseil finalizing technical & resettlement design
  - RN6/Kolda Bridge: Louis Berger-AGEIM finalizing technical and resettlement design
  - Land tenure preparatory work being finalized by FIT/CIRAD/SONED Afrique
  - Baseline survey being produced by Senegal's National Statistical Agency (ANSD)
  - Implementing Entity PMUs operational within AGEROUTE (roads) /SAED (irrigation)
- Bidding documents for works expected to begin launch in **March 2012**
