

U.S. Embassy Move, Consular Section Closures

The U.S. Embassy Dakar will soon move to its new location, halting services at the current downtown building. The new Embassy will be located on Route des Almadies in Dakar, just north of the King Fahd hotel.

During this transition, the Consular Section at the Embassy will be closed from Thursday, February 21, through Monday, February 25. There will be no regular-service appointments, such as passport renewals or Consular Reports of Birth Abroad, during these days. U.S. citizens with items to retrieve from the consular section, such as passports, should not come to either Embassy location during these dates.

During the February 21-25 closure, Embassy staff will be available for U.S. citizen emergencies **only**. If you have an emergency during this timeframe, please call the Duty Officer at 77-333-3659. After February 25, please use the new Embassy phone number, below, to be routed to the correct personnel.

Routine services will resume, in limited capacity, at the new Embassy building on February 26. Per usual, routine services will be offered [by appointment only](#). Passports and Consular Reports of Birth Abroad can be picked up during regular afternoon hours (2 to 4 p.m.) at the new location beginning February 26.
