HOW TO REGISTER for this event:

Applicants are required to schedule for their interview appointments online, via the Global Entry Online System (GOES) website at <https://goes-app.cbp.dhs.gov> .

- Logon your GOES account, schedule for any available appointment slot within these 3 dates: September 9, 10 and 11, 2014.
- From the Interview location drop down for Enrollment Center: select **"Singapore, American Chamber of Commerce, 1 Scotts Road, Shaw Centre 23-03, Singapore, SG"**.
- Your interview appointment can be for Global Entry, or APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC), or Both. You can now apply for Global Entry and ABTC simultaneously, if you enrolled in the CBP Trusted Traveler Program for the first time, from June 14, 2014 onwards.

Background:

Global Entry is a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) program that enables members entering the United States expedited Customs and Immigration processing by using automated Global Entry kiosks located at over 30 major U.S. airports and at airports in Canada and Ireland that have United States Customs preclearance lanes. The U.S. **APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC)** Program is a voluntary program to facilitate travel for U.S. citizens engaged in verified business in the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) region and U.S. government officials engaged in APEC business. Participants must also be members of a CBP trusted traveler program. The U.S. APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC) will enable access to a dedicated fast-track lane for expedited immigration processing at participating foreign APEC member airports. U.S. ABTC holders may also use the Global Entry kiosks at participating airports upon their U.S. return.
