

Q & A – VPN and DIN

1. Q: What is the distance from telco demark to the Main Frame for all locations? (Distance Unknown)

A: Addresses for South Africa have been provided in the solicitation as follows:

US EMBASSY IN PRETORIA

The U.S. address cannot be provided as the Embassy believes this information is not needed for a proposal. It is important to clarify that the Embassy is NOT seeking fully managed services VPN path. Rather the Embassy will fully manage its internal VPN tunnel.

2. Q: Would you forward a copy of Form 1449?
A: The Form 1449 was sent to all offerors under the names, VPN Main SF1449, DTS SF1449 and VPN Main SF1449.
3. Q: Please provide GPS coordinates for all 4 sites which require VPN
A: Please see Question 1
4. Q: Please supply address and GPS coordinates of Data Centre located in Washington
A: Refer to Question 1.
5. Q: Kindly elaborate on the statement below under Section 5 – Offeror Representations and Certifications; “If an offeror has not completed the annual representation and certifications electronically at the ORCA website, the offeror shall complete only paragraph (c) through (o) of this provision”.
A: These are legal provisions. Kindly consult your internal legal team for guidance. However, if the offeror has not visited the ORCA website, they have the option of completing paragraphs (c) to (o) of the provisions.
6. Q: Please could you advise: “Looking at the detailed RFQ you have sent, am not sure what we can add and there is nothing that I have seen in the document that states we can add additional pricing sections?”
A: The pricing schedule in the solicitation suffices. The offeror may include additional information, making note of this in the submission.
