##### PEPFAR Implementing Partners on Reverse Side

#### PEPFAR Overview

Since 2004, PEPFAR has invested more than \$4.2 billion in SA in response to the HIV/AIDS and TB epidemics. PEPFAR works in partnership with national, provincial and local governments, with non-governmental and faith-based organizations, and with academia and the private sector to scale up life-saving HIV/AIDS prevention, care and treatment services across SA. Joint national outcomes include:

- 2,400,000 million HIV-positive individuals on antiretroviral treatment,
- Reduction in mother-to-child transmission rate of HIV to less than 3%,
- 6,617,300 individuals received HIV counseling and testing,
- 295,000 men received medical male circumcision as part of a package of prevention services, and
- 177,000 orphans and vulnerable children were reached with care services.

#### HIV in the Province

The sexually active age group (males and females, aged 15—49 years) represents 53.0% of KwaZulu-Natal's population<sup>7</sup>; HIV prevalence amongst this age group is 27.6%<sup>8</sup>. According to recently released DoH data, KwaZulu-Natal recorded a notable decrease in antenatal HIV prevalence of 2.1% from 39.5% to 37.4% (95% CI: 35.8 – 39.0%)<sup>9</sup>. However, the prevalence in some districts, still remains above 40%, including Ugu and uMkhanyakude which both recorded HIV prevalence of 41.7% and 41.1% respectively among pregnant women<sup>9</sup>.

#### PEPFAR's Current Work

The USG works in close partnership with the SAG to achieve the goals of zero new HIV and TB infections, zero new infections due to vertical transmission, zero preventable deaths associated with HIV and TB, and zero discrimination associated with HIV, STIs, and TB. In August 2012, the US and SA governments signed a Partnership Framework Implementation Plan which outlines joint investments through 2017 to further reduce HIV infections and build health systems capacity. PEPFAR works in alliance with KwaZulu-Natal's provincial and local governments to strengthen its health system infrastructure through ensuring high quality standard of care at health facilities; enhancing training, recruiting, and strengthening human resource systems for clinicians, community health workers, and managers; strengthening use and data capturing of routine health information systems, including ETR, EDR, Tier.net, and DHIS; and promoting evidence-informed planning. Additionally, a number of PEPFAR implementing partners work on prevention efforts with key populations including commercial sex workers, migrant workers and long-distance truck drivers, farm workers, and men who have sex with men (MSM).

#### KwaZulu-Natal Achievements

Through the district health partners, PEPFAR has supported the provincial government to reach the following **Milestones in 2013:**

- 750,000 HIV-positive individuals on antiretroviral treatment, and
- 1,341,000 individuals received HIV counseling and testing.

Additionally, for 2013, PEPFAR implementing partners in the province contributed directly to:

- 92,000 male circumcisions, contributing to 33.7% of the provincial target;  
*\*Since 2010, PEPFAR partners have conducted more than 195,000 MMCs in KwaZulu-Natal*
- 39,000 orphans and vulnerable children reached with care services;
- 1,300 Health Care workers graduated from a pre-service training institution, and
- 2,000 Health Care workers completed a SAQA-accredited in-service training program and 1,000 clinicians and caregivers completed a pediatric ART, TB, MMC, or palliative care course.

#### Provincial Highlight


From 2011 to 2013, BroadReach Health Care (a USAID PEPFAR funded partner) worked closely with the Office of the KZN Premier to develop a standardized provincial training curriculum for community caregivers (CCGs) and trained 2000 CCGs. Due to the recognized success of the training program, PEPFAR implementing partners will be partnering with KZN government to support a provincial rollout of the training to an additional 8000 CCGs. The training empowers CCGs to raise awareness, educate, screen, and refer individuals in need to appropriate service providers and to holistically address HIV/AIDS in some of the most rural and underserved communities of KZN. In commitment to the power of partnerships, PEPFAR will work alongside KZN's provincial government to encourage and support the training and capacity building of its caregivers and further provincial PHC reengineering goals and health systems strengthening.
