Demonstration Notice – March 1, 2013

MADRID DEMONSTRATIONS PLANNED FOR MARCH 1 – 8

Planned and spontaneous demonstrations take place in Spain regularly, especially in Madrid and Barcelona, in response to economic or other events. If you encounter a large public gathering or demonstration, the U.S. Embassy suggests that you avoid the area. Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational. U.S. citizens are therefore urged to avoid the areas of demonstrations if possible, and to exercise caution if within the vicinity of any demonstrations.

The Government Delegation in Madrid has authorized a number of demonstrations for the period from Friday, March 01 through Friday, March 08 listed below.
